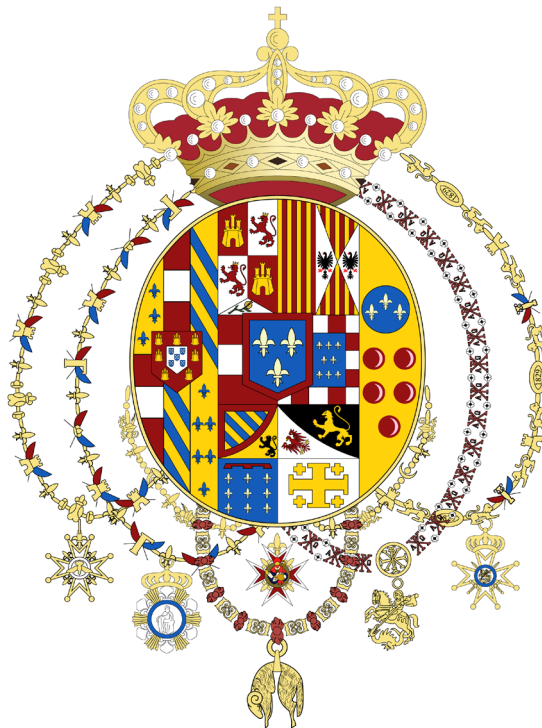


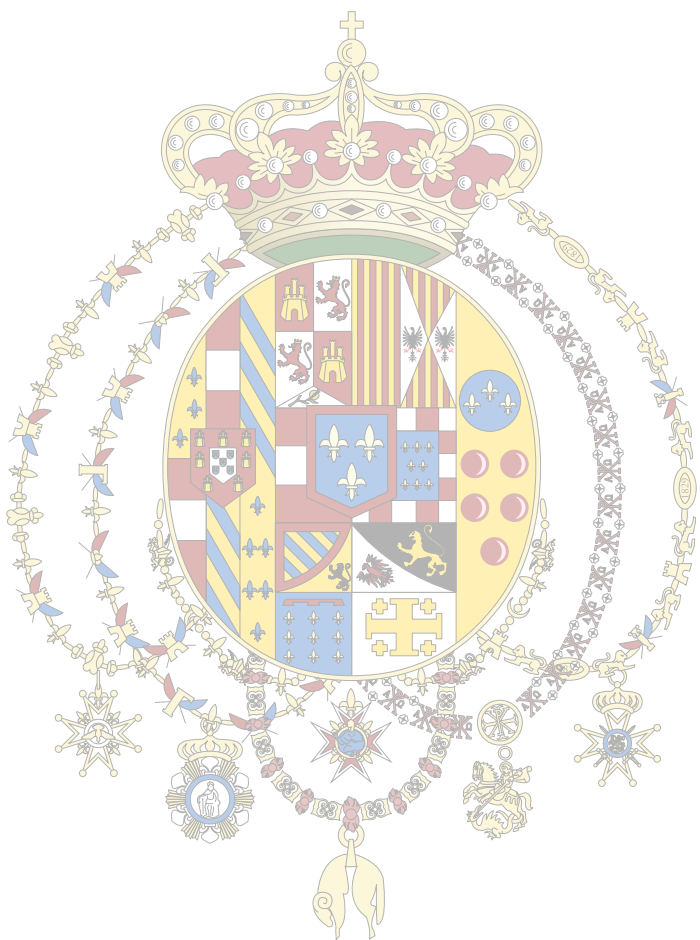

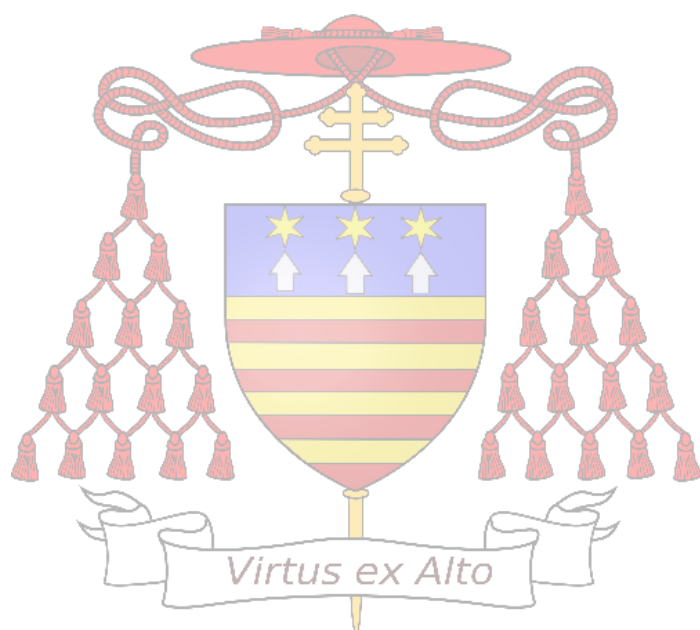

History of the Delegation in Great Britain



The first known British subject to be invested into the Sacred Military Constantinian Order of Saint George was Captain William D'Arley, who received the decoration from King Ferdinand I of the Two Sicilies in 1801. In the same year, he obtained a Royal Licence from King George III of Great Britain which permitted him to be styled as "*Sir William*" and to wear the Order's decoration at Court.

In 1810, Sir John Carr was invested into the Order's ranks. Several members of the Winspeare and Acton families, who had close ties to the Royal Neapolitan Court, were invested in the middle of the nineteenth century. In 1883, the industrialist and inventor, Sir Edward Thomason, was invested into the Order's ranks.

In the first 75 years of the 20th century the Anglo-Neapolitan families of Acton and Winspeare were again the mainstay of British members of the Sacred Military Constantinian Order. Sir Harold Acton, famous for his two-volume history of the Bourbons of Naples, became a Constantinian knight.

In the early 1970's some prominent members of the British and Polish Associations of the Order of Malta decided to establish a national association for the Constantinian Order in Britain and Ireland. In 1975 the premier baron of England, Lord Mowbray, Segrave and Stourton, was elected as its president and remained in office until 2000.

Among those invested during this time were five presidents of the British Association of the Order of Malta including Lord Craigmyle, Major-General Viscount Monckton of Brenchley, Sir John Hope and Captain Peregrine Bertie.

Other members included Viscount Furness and eminent members of the College of Arms including the future Garter King of Arms Sir Conrad Swan and John Brooke-Little, later Clarenceux Arms.

Among activities undertaken by the Delegation in the early years were the publication of the first history of the Order in English entitled '*Italy's Knights of St George: The Constantinian Order*' by Desmond Seward, the attendance of many British and Irish knights and dames at the state funeral of the last monarchs of the Two Sicilies, King Francis II and Queen Sofia in the Basilica of Santa Chiara in Naples in 1984, and a ground breaking exhibition on the art and civilization under the Bourbons in southern Italy was created and presented at the Neapolitan museums of Capodimonte and San Martino and at the Detroit Institute of Art in the USA.

HE Archbishop Luigi Barbarito, was invested into the Constantinian Order in 1986 at the start of his eleven year term as Apostolic Nuncio to the Court of St James's. The Rt Rev Mgr Adrian Arrowsmith, Canon of Westminster Cathedral, became the new Prior of the delegation and placed a special chapel of the Pro-Cathedral of London at the disposal of the knights and dames.

Members of the Recusant aristocracy were also invested including HMEH Frà Andrew Bertie, Prince and Grand Master of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta. The late Lord High Chancellor, Lord Hailsham of Saint Marylebone, was also appointed a medalist of the Constantinian Order.

The Delegation and its activities grew considerably further from 2000 onwards under delegates Lord Belhaven and Stenton (2000-2003), Mr Anthony Bailey (2003-2006) and Lord Brennan of Bibury QC (2006-2009).

The delegation membership in Britain today includes Royalty, Peers of the Realm, judges and lawyers, Members of Parliament, authors, charity workers, diplomats, businessmen, ministers, civil leaders, interfaith campaigners, military leaders and senior clergy.

Among them are HMEH Frà Matthew Festing, current Prince and Grand Master of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta, HSH Princess Marie-Therese von Hohenberg Mrs Anthony Bailey, Sister Ellen Flynn of the Passage Homeless Centre, The Dowager Marchioness of Salisbury (medalist), The Duchess of Norfolk, the former Chief Minister of Gibraltar Sir Peter Caruana, QC, the Lord High Constable of Scotland the Earl of Erroll (medalist), former Chief of the Defence Staff Field Marshal The Lord Guthrie of Craigiebank, former Attorney General Baroness Scotland of Asthal, QC, several ambassadors accredited to the Court of St James's and former MP, pro-life campaigner and entertainer Ann Widdecombe.

The senior dame of the Delegation in Britain is Her Royal Highness Princess Michael of Kent who was invested into the Sacred Military Constantinian Order in 1996.

His Eminence Cormac, Cardinal Murphy-O'Connor, Archbishop Emeritus of Westminster, is the current Prior of the British and Irish Delegation. Since 2001, the Most Rev George Stack, Archbishop of Cardiff, has served as Sub-Prior of the British and Irish Delegation. The current Archbishop of Westminster, His Grace The Most Reverend Vincent Nichols is a longstanding chaplain of the British and Irish Delegation having first been invested into the Order in 1990.

In 2012 HE Archbishop Antonio Mennini was invested into the Constantinian Order at the start of his term as Apostolic Nuncio to the Court of St James's.

Within the Royal Order of Francis I, which is not exclusively Roman Catholic in nature, are foreign royalty, a former prime minister, charity workers, artists, cabinet ministers, barristers, academics, inter-faith leaders, businessmen and Members of Parliament.

Among them are Lord Archbishop of Canterbury Emeritus - Lord Williams of Oystermouth, and his predecessor Lord Carey of Clifton, The Duke of Westminster, HRH The Princess Elena of Romania, Knight Principal Lord Lingfield, HRH Princess Katarina of Yugoslavia, Lord Denman, inter-faith leader Sir Sigmund Sternberg, Baroness Margaret Thatcher, Albert Roux, Greek Orthodox Archbishop Gregorios of Thyateira and Great Britain, Syrian Orthodox Archbishop Athanasius Toma Dawod, President of the Board of British Jews Vivian Wine-man, as well as a number of current and past Ambassadors and High Commissioners accredited to the Court of St James's including from Italy, Ireland, Poland, Colombia, Hungary, Andorra, Yemen and the Holy See.

The current British and Irish delegate is HE Mr Anthony Bailey (2009-2012 & 2012+) who simultaneously serves as the Order's worldwide Grand Magistral Delegete for Inter-Religious Relations. He is supported by a Council, which is elected every three years. The Vice-Delegate for England is Professor The Lord Alton of Liverpool, the Vice-Delegate for Scotland is Field Marshal The Lord Guthrie of Craigiebank and the Vice-Delegate for Wales is The Rt Hon Paul Murphy, MP.

The Delegation in Great Britain supports numerous worthy charities and organisations including The Passage Homeless Centre, St Thomas Fund, Westminster Cathedral, Blind Veterans UK (St Dunstan's), The Council of Christians and Jews, The Schola of the London Oratory School, Tyburn Convent and Shrine, the Apostolic Nunciature, the All-Party Parliamentary Pro-Life Group within the British Parliament, and many of the international charitable and humanitarian initiatives of the Grand Magistrty in Rome.



History of the Delegation in Ireland



Over the last century there have been numerous knights and dames invested into the Constantinian Order from across the island of Ireland including members of the old Gaelic nobility, the Order of Malta, the clergy as well as parliamentarians, leading businessmen and academics.

The first known Irishman to be invested into the Order was Benedetto Harvey who was appointed a Knight of Grace in 1728. The late Denis O'Connor Don, Head of the House of Connaught, and descendant of the dynasty that ruled as High Kings of Ireland until the Anglo-Norman conquest at the end of the twelfth century, was a member.

In 2004 Professor Mary McAleese, President of Ireland, was awarded the Collar of the Constantinian Order at a ceremony at Aras an Uachtaráin, and Taoiseach (Prime Minister) Bertie Ahern, TD, then President of the European Council, was also honoured. Other knights include former Taoiseach (Prime Minister) John Bruton and Donal Downes, President of the Association of Papal Orders in Ireland until 2012.

The Delegation's Vice-Delegate for Ireland is Professor Richard Conroy (2009-2012 & 2012+). Other members in Ireland include Michael Joseph McDonnell, former Lieutenant of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre, HE Mr Dáithí O'Ceallaigh, former Ambassador of Ireland to the Court of James's and the UN in Geneva, The Rt Hon Paul Murphy, MP, former Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, a former Lord Mayor of Dublin and the President of the Association of Papal Orders in Ireland, Professor Vincent McBrierty and Mr Andrew Rogers.

Among other Irish members are former Vice President of the Irish Association of the Order of Malta, Mr Patrick White, the Association's former Chancellor the late Sean Kevin Cunnane, his successor John Igoe, and the Chancellor of the Papal Orders in Ireland, former Independent Assessor of Military Complaints Procedures and in Northern Ireland James McDonald.

The Order's Chief Chaplain for Ireland is the Archbishop Emeritus of Dublin, His Eminence Desmond, Cardinal Connell, who was invested into the Constantinian Order in November 2002. The Most Rev Dr Raymond Field, Auxiliary Bishop of Dublin, is a chaplain of the Delegation. Current Irish knights of the Royal Order of Francis I include businessman Sir Michael Smurfit, and the former Speaker of the Northern Ireland Assembly, Lord Alderdice of Knock.

Across the island of Ireland, numerous charitable initiatives have been adopted and supported. In Northern Ireland the Forthspring Inter-Community Group in Belfast, and Co-operation Ireland which both work to bridge the divided communities in the province, has been supported by the Delegation. In the Irish Republic, the DePaul Trust of Ireland and Citywise, which seeks to educate children and teenagers who have dropped out of society, are among the charitable bodies which have been supported by the Delegation.

The Delegation of Great Britain and Ireland observes the Order's feast days, particularly the Feast of Saint George (23 April), and the Glorification of the Cross (14 September).
